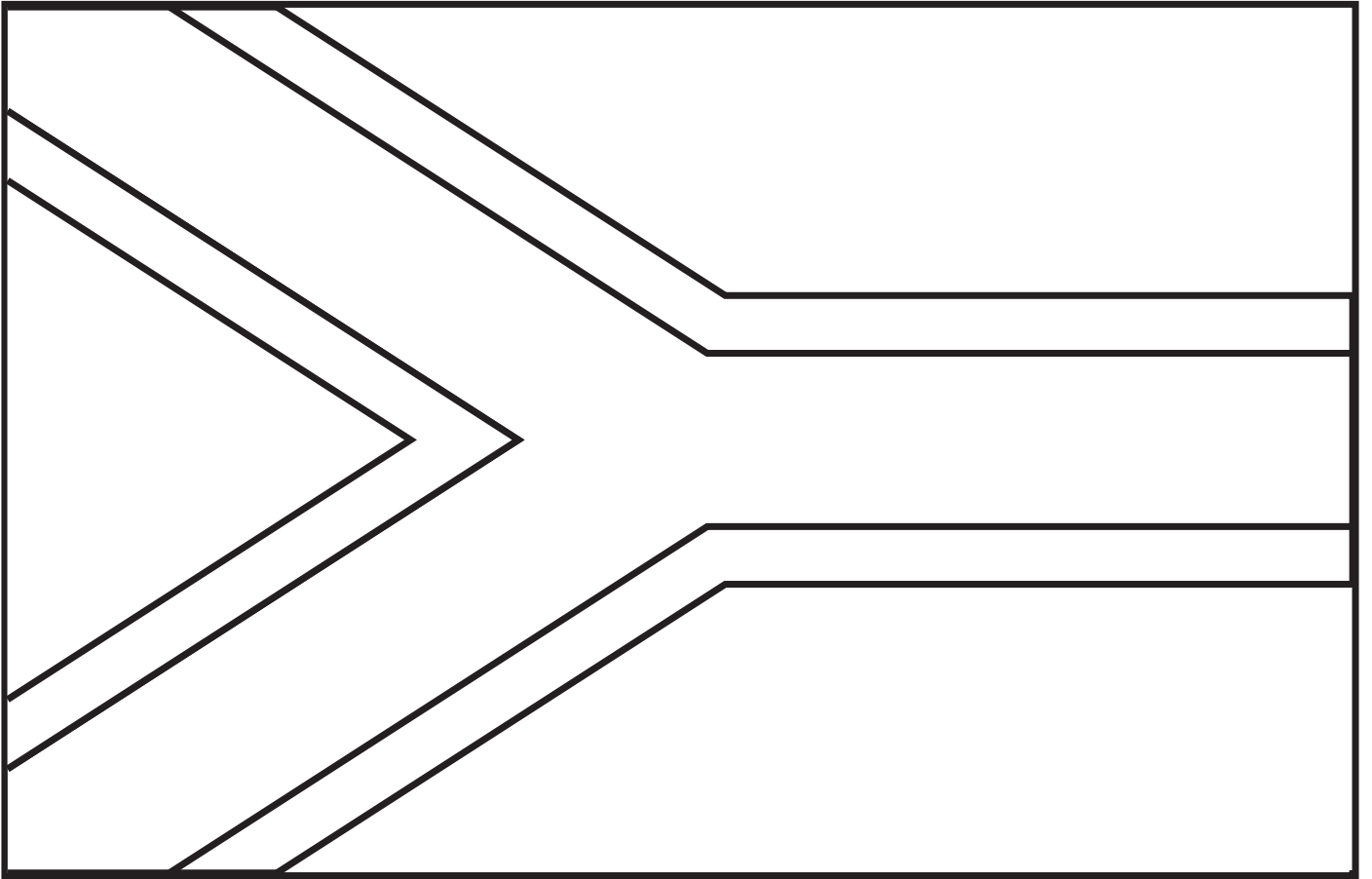
South Africa
